#### **Activity Ideas**

**Use Google Maps to find Lake Macquarie**. Use the satellite option to look at the lake and label places of interest that you have been to before.

**Does it sink or float?** Collect a range of objects from around the house include items that are made of different materials e.g. metal, cork, plastic etc. Make predictions whether the items and will sink or float. Test your predictions.

**Make a Terrarium.** Using a large plastic sandwich bag add some dirt (enough to grow a plant), flower or bean seeds and some water. Seal the bag and place in a sunny spot. Watch the plants grow and learn about the water cycle.



**Build a Boat.** Collect different size containers and other household items and build your own boat (hint use the items from the floating experiment). Please send photos to the school of your creations to post of facebook.
